1. Good afternoon fellow compatriots. Today we are reporting twenty-seven (27) new COVID-19 confirmed cases identified from one thousand and eighty-one (1 081) tests performed at the various laboratories. This number constitutes 2.5% positivity ratio. The gender distribution of the cases is eighteen (18) females and nine (9) males. The age range is from twenty-one (21) years to fifty-eight (58) years. The new COVID-19 cases are distributed as follows:

- 3. Today we are reporting fifty-five (55) new recoveries. This brings the total number of recoveries to 12 243.
