1. Good afternoon fellow Namibians. We have recorded seventy-two new Covid-19 positive cases, all of who are Namibians. One is from Windhoek, one from Katima Mulilo, two from Swakopmund and 68 from Walvis Bay. The one in Windhoek, is admitted in a local hospital. The one from Katima Mulilo travelled from Walvis Bay. Thirty-nine are males and thirty-three are females. The youngest one is 9 months old and the oldest one is 62 years old. The applicable protocols for the management of Covid-19 positive cases are being implemented.
