



PUBLIC NOTICE

on AirBNB

Under the Namibia Tourism Board Act 21 of 2000, it is unlawful for any individual to offer overnight accommodation to paying guests without being registered with the Namibia Tourism Board.

SECTION 19

Stipulates that any person who provides accommodation to a tourist in an accommodation establishment that is not registered under section 20 commits an offense and shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding N\$20 000 or to imprisonment not exceeding two years or to both such fine and such imprisonment.

SECTION 20

Requires any person who intends to conduct an accommodation establishment shall apply to the Namibia Tourism Board for the registration of such accommodation establishment.

As such, all individuals offering accommodation through platforms such as Airbnb are kindly requested to ensure compliance with Namibian law by registering their establishments with the Namibia Tourism Board no later than 30th April 2025.

Failure to do so will result in legal action, including criminal proceedings, against non-compliant individuals.
