## Namibia2Go gets new Head Office at HKIA

Gondwana Collection Namibia proudly announces the commencement of a long-anticipated construction project at the gates of Windhoek's Hosea Kutako International Airport. The groundbreaking ceremony, which took place on 19 January 2024, marks a significant milestone for the Namibia 2Go car rental, as it prepares to establish its new home at the turn-off from the B6 to the airport.

Acquired in early 2020, the future Namibia2Go premises will sprawl across two erven in the SUNGATE precinct. "We are excited to announce our partnership with architect Sven-Erik Staby from Staby Design, in collaboration with main contractor Gaia Investments P/L, for this groundbreaking project," said Gondwana's Operations Director, Alain Noirfalise. The official opening date is set for September 2024.

Over the years, Namibia2Go has grown considerably, relocating from Bismarck Street to its current location in Bassingthwaighte Street, Klein Windhoek, in 2019. Today, with a team of 32 dedicated members and a diverse fleet of 278 rental vehicles across various categories, the existing space has become limited.
