- N\$ 16 million budget has been set aside for the renovations.

"Some of the resorts such as Okaukuejo are already complete with renovations. Major work will mostly be carried out at Onkoshi and Sossuss Dune Lodge where decks and roofing types will completely be changed" Ashipala further said.

NWR would hereby also like to inform their guests for patience as most of the resorts will be busy with construction work. Some of the resorts still to be refurbished are Onkoshi, Ai –Ais, Waterberg Sossus Dune Lodge and Hardap Dam Resort.
