INFORMATION ON SOSSUSVLEI SHUTTLE SERVICES AND DEADVLEI ACCESS

The Ministry of Environment, Forestry and Tourism wishes to inform the public and all stakeholders that, effective 01 May 2026, only the following operators will be authorised to operate shuttle services between the Sossusvlei 2x4 parking area and the 4x4 parking area (Deadvlei):

1. Grow Namibia trading as About Adelt Sossusvlei Management, and
2. Tour guides employed by the lodges within and around the Namib-Naukluft Park and registered with the Namibia Tourism Board, who may transport their own clients.

No other operators will be permitted to provide shuttle services to the Sossusvlei 4x4 parking area (Deadvlei). Accordingly, all visitors to Deadvlei will be required to use the authorised shuttle service, and self-driving by tourists beyond the 2x4 parking area will not be permitted. This is part of the Ministry's concession agreement and includes the control of access into the Deadvlei area.
