RE: NEW CONSERVATION FEES

Reference is made to the above subject.

Zimparks would like to advise that following engagements with stakeholders a decision has been made to defer the implementation of the increase in Park Entry fees until the second quarter of 2023. This is meant to allow stakeholders ample time to update trade partners and travellers of the changes. The changes will be implemented on 1 April 2023.

Zimparks would like to advise also that in an effort to support domestic tourism, the local conservation fee for Rainforest of USD\$7 will remain in force. The Authority has agreed to maintain it as it is.

We remain committed to supporting the ongoing recovery efforts for the tourism sector in Zimbabwe whilst ensuring that we continue to conserve and protect our natural heritage and protected parks estates under our mandate across Zimbabwe.
