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VERIFICATION OF COVID-19 VACCINATION CERTIFICATES ON THE TRUSTED TRAVEL SYSTEM AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR PERSONS WITH DOMICILE

The Government of Namibia has implemented the Trusted Travel System (TTS) used for verification and authentication of COVID-19 test results and vaccination certificates. Currently the system is only used to upload and verify COVID-19 test results.

This public notice serves to inform the public that the Ministry is busy working on the Trusted Vaccine module which will enable travelers to upload their COVID-19 vaccination certificates for validation and verification at Points of Entry.

- Persons permitted to enter Namibia with vaccination certificates are therefore advised to carry hard copies of their vaccination certificate and not upload them on the Trusted Travel System
- Travelers will be informed when the Trusted Vaccine module is ready for use.

Entry requirements for persons with domicile

Entry requirements into Namibia were amended on Thursday, 14 January 2022, to allow fully vaccinated Namibians, Permanent Residents and Truck Drivers to enter Namibia with a valid and authentic Vaccination Certificate, without presenting a negative PCR test result.

The Ministry would therefore like to notify the public, Port Health officials and Immigration officials that persons with domicile status who have been fully vaccinated, are also included in these provisions and can enter Namibia without presenting a negative PCR test.

The MoHSS would like to thank all travelers for their understanding and cooperation towards improving Namibia's COVID-19 response.
