

UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

25 June 2020 (late edition)

WINDHOEK*Check Against Delivery

1. Good evening Fellow Namibians! We have 12 new Covid-19 positive cases which brings the total number to over a 100 mark. They are all from Erongo region, 11 from Walvis Bay and 1 from Swakopmund. Seven are contacts of confirmed cases. Six had no COVID-19 related symptoms, while five had symptoms at the time of testing.

2. Case No 91

A 29-years old Namibian female from Walvis Bay. She was tested on the 22 June 2020 as part of active cases search. No known contact to a confirmed case. Contact tracing will start immediately. She presented with COVID-19 related symptoms. The result came out positive. She is in a satisfactory condition.

3. Case No 92

A 37-years old Namibian male from Walvis Bay. He was tested on the 22 June 2020 as part of active cases search. No known contact to a confirmed case. Contact tracing will start immediately. He had no COVID-19 related symptoms. The result came out positive. His condition is satisfactory.

4. Case No 93

A 27-years old Namibian female from Walvis Bay. She is a contact of a confirmed case. She was tested on the 22 June 2020. She had COVID-19 related symptoms. The result came out positive. Her condition is satisfactory.

5. Case No 94

A 23-years old Namibian male from Walvis Bay. No known contact to a confirmed case. He was tested on the 22 June 2020 as he presented with COVID-19 related symptoms. The result came out positive. His condition is satisfactory. Contact tracing will commence immediately.

6. Case No 95

A 35-years old Namibian female from Walvis Bay with no known contact to a confirmed case. She was tested on the 22 June 2020 as she presented with COVID-19 related symptoms. The result came out positive. She is in satisfactory condition. Contact tracing will commence immediately to establish the source of infection.

7. Case No 96

A 37-years old Namibian female from Walvis Bay. She is a contact of a confirmed case. She was tested on the 22 June 2020. She presented with COVID-19 related symptoms. The result came out positive. She is in a satisfactory condition.

8. Case No 97

A 25-years old Namibian female from Walvis Bay. She is a contact of a confirmed case. She was tested on the 22 June 2020. She had no COVID-19 related symptoms at that time. The result came out positive. She is in a satisfactory condition.

9. Case No 98

A 50-years old Namibian female from Walvis Bay, a contact of the confirmed case, swabbed on the 22 June 2020. She had no COVID-19 related symptoms. The result came out positive. Her condition is satisfactory.

10. Case No 99

A 21-years old Namibian female from Walvis Bay and a contact of the confirmed case. She was tested on the 22 June 2020. At that time, she had no COVID-19 related symptoms. The result came out positive. She is in a satisfactory condition.

11. Case No 100

A 6-years old Namibian male from Swakopmund became Case No 100. He is a contact of a confirmed case. He was tested on the 22 June 2020. At the time he had no COVID-19 related symptoms. The result came out positive. He is in a satisfactory condition.

12. Case No 101

Is a 22-years old Namibian female from Walvis Bay and a contact of a confirmed case. She was tested on the 22 June 2020. At the time, she had no COVID-19 related symptoms. The result came out positive. She is in a satisfactory condition.

13. Case No 102

A 39-years old Namibian male from Walvis Bay with no known contact to a confirmed case. He was tested on the 22 June 2020 as he presented with COVID-19 related symptoms. The result came out positive. He is in a satisfactory condition. Contact tracing will commence immediately to establish the source of infection as well as those who might have been exposed.
