PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT

TRAVELERS AND BORDER PASSES

- 1. The Ministry of Home Affairs and Immigration would like to inform its esteemed clients and the public at large that Border Passes will only be issued to people who are border residents.
- 2. Border Passes can only be used to travel within 60 KM radius. People from areas beyond 60 KM radius of the borderlines are encouraged to make use of national travelling documents (passport or Emergency Travelling Certificate). Emergency travelling Certificate can only be obtained from our Oshana Regional Office in Oshakati.
- 3. Travelers must be in possession of vaccination cards at all times, this includes holders of Passports and Border Passes.
- 4. Travelers accompanied by child/children must be in possession of the children's birth certificates for the specific children in addition to the passport. In addition, the traveler accompanied by child/children must have an affidavit from the parent/s, authorizing the child/children to travel with him/her.
