**UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.**

**26 June 2020**

1. Good morning Fellow Namibians! We have a one recovery and three new Covid-19 positive cases. Case No 31 has recovered fully and has been discharged from our facility.
  
2. **Case No 103**  
 A 15-years old Namibian female travelled from India by flight via OR Tambo International Airport South Africa and arrived in Namibia on 25 May 2020. She has been in quarantine since then. She was tested on the 6<sup>th</sup> June 2020 and results came out on the 7<sup>th</sup> June 2020, **negative**. Her quarantine period was extended as she was in contact with one who tested positive in the same quarantine. She was then re-tested on the 22 June 2020 and result came out on 25 June 2020 **positive**. She does not have COVID-19 related symptoms.
  
3. **Case No 104**  
 A 40-years old Namibian male from Walvis Bay who is a contact of the confirmed case. He was tested on the 22 June 2020. He did not display any COVID-19 related symptoms. The result came out positive. He is in a satisfactory condition.
  
4. **Case No 105**  
 A 43-years old Namibian male from Walvis Bay who is a contact of a known confirmed case. He was tested on the 22 June 2020. He had no COVID-19 related symptoms. The result came out positive. He is in a satisfactory condition.
  
5. The status of Covid-19 in Namibian is as following:
  - Confirmed Cases: 105
  - Recoveries: 22
  - Active Cases: 83
  - Deaths: 0
  - Total samples tested 8 105
  - Total tested yesterday: 91
  - Results: 3 positives
  - Active contacts: 307
  - Total quarantined: 3 713
  - Total discharged: 2 880
  - Total in quarantine: 833
