

# Olifantsrus Fact Sheet

## LOCATION

The campsite is situated approximately 130 km from Okaukuejo, 60 km from the Galton gate (Otjo-vasandu) and 50 km from the Dolomite camp. GPS coordinates and maps will be made available at a later stage.

## ACCOMMODATION

The facilities boast 10 camp sites.

The campsites take a maximum of 8 pax per site and cost N\$ 250 per person per night. Currently, there are no braai facilities for campers, only flat bases to make fire.

## CATEGORIES

The campsite has an information centre. There's a communal kitchen with a 2 plate gas stove and a fridge with toilets next to it. There is ablution blocks (toilets and showers) for both male & female campers and day visitors.

The kiosk sells beverages, light meals, snacks and drinks. The camp only accepts cash as method of payments as no card facilities are in place.

## THINGS TO DO

One of the key attractions of Olifanstrus campsite is the state of the art hide which is probably the first of its kind in Sub-Saharan Africa or Southern Africa. This is a double story building (hut) with aluminium glasses around it in front of a man made waterhole engineered for peaceful game viewing . The deck hide is 4m from the ground.

## OPERATING TIMES

The camp opens at sunrise and closes at sunset as per the general park regulations and day visitors are only allowed to use the picnic facilities until 16h00.



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
