## PENSIONER INVESTORS FOR NAMIBIA

Pensioners can apply for Permanent Residence in Namibia on the following grounds:

- 1. They must be 60 years or older. If they are younger, they apply at own risk. We cannot guarantee that it will be approved. Some applications are successful depending on the background of the applicant.
- 2. They must be retired. If they apply while still working, it is also at own risk.
- 3. They have to make a fixed investment in Namibia before applying for Permanent Residence: ownership of property or government treasury bonds. Some people make other investments. The government sometimes accept this.
  - If they do not make a fixed investment, it is at own risk. We cannot guarantee that the permit will be approved. If it is rejected, we can appeal. We will then advise and try our best to get the approval with the appeal.
- 4. They must give proof of enough income as pensioners thus bank statements etc.
- 5. They must also give enough proof of financial security, for instance investments etc.
