- 2 For interlining and through-check-in on routings where other carriers are involved, give the passenger the choice of checking-in the sport baggage for all the Air Namibia flight numbers and to check-in new for all non-Air Namibia or do a through check-in and charge passenger for all sectors on the applicable PC excess baggage rates or 1.5% per kg.
- 3 Travel agent or SW sales office can prepay another pc of bag or sports equipment for passenger through GDS/MCO or VMPD
- 4 In general, sporting equipment is treated like any other baggage. Thus, if a passenger is only traveling with sporting equipment, then sport equipment becomes the passenger's Free Baggage Allowance (FBA) if the
